The Foresters showed two different "personalities" en route to winning a record seventh national title. Santa Barbara started out ready to annihilate tournament offensive team records, scoring 38 runs and batting .516 after two games in pool play. But after being shut out by Seattle (Wash.) in the third game of pool play, the Foresters became a grind it out team, winning two of three games in the knockout rounds in their final at bats and put the other game away with a five-run eighth.

Santa Barbara finished by leading the tournament in batting average (.332), slugging percentage (.523) and home runs (6). The offense carried the pitching staff, which allowed less than five runs just once, and finished near the bottom of the top 10 teams with a 6.32 ERA.
