The Foresters dominated in all phases to win their eighth title, all since 2005, outscoring their opponents 33-4, setting an NBCWS Modern Wood Era record with a 1.06 team ERA despite allowing three runs in the ninth inning of the final game and became the first team to finish the tournament with a 1.000 fielding percentage in four games.

Santa Barbara finished third in batting average (.277), second in stolen bases (14 of 16) and allowed only one stolen base in three tries.
